



Anaphylaxis is a severe and potentially fatal allergic reaction that can occur within minutes of an insect sting.²

WASPS


Wasps are predators and are slender with smooth bodies and slender legs.

BEES

Bees are pollinators and are hairy and robust with flat legs for gathering pollen.

Anaphylactic reactions that may occur within **minutes** after exposure include:²

itching
rash
hives
swelling
breathing difficulties
abdominal pain
rapid heart rate
abnormally low blood pressure
cardiac arrest.

hypersensitive to insect stings, meaning they're at risk of anaphylactic shock if they're stung by an insect, such as a wasp or bee.^{1,3}
